GRAMMATA ON HOLY MYRON (CHRISM)

Holy Chrism is given for use in each dependency and remains property of the Exarchate. However, the Holy Chrism is in care of the main clergyman (superior, pastor) assigned to the dependency.

A dependency is a parish, mission or ministry, an institution or monastic community of the Exarchate as approved by the Exarch.

Holy Chrism is to be kept either in the Artophorion or a special lock box (tabernacle) mounted on the wall in the sanctuary (holy altar space).

Holy Chrism is to be used for Chrismation exclusively. No other person than a priest in good standing of the Exarchate is allowed to handle or administer Holy Chrism.

Upon the dissolution of a dependency or by request of the bishop, the Holy Chrism is to be returned to the diocesan offices preferably in person or, if not possible, via certified, special delivery.
